- Moore High School will host a safe trick or treat night on Thursday, October 28th from 5:30-7:30 p.m. The event will be sponsored by the sophomore class.
- Belinda Jolly, DECA sponsor at Moore High School, has been selected to attend an economic forum in San Antonio. Ms. Jolly was one of only three teachers chosen from the State of Oklahoma to attend.
- Rhonda Boyd and Valerie Ferguson of Moore High School have been selected to participate in the State Superintendent's Master Teacher Project to identify and train master teachers across the state.
- The Agricultural program at Moore High School recently won the Grand Champion Youth Longhorn Showing.
- The Horticulture program won "Grand Champion Horticultural Display" at the recent State competition. This marks the 12th year in a row that Moore High School has won this competition.
