

MINUTES of the Moore Board of Education

Regular Meeting
March 20, 2006

Mr. Walt Larsen, President of the Board of Education, called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Mrs. Arato presented the following information during the SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT:

-----In Elementary News:

Red Oak had eleven 4th graders who participated in the State Invention Fair. The following three students received special recognition at the Fair: Jullian Buxton, Emily Terranova and Jordan Powell.

Kyle Harney, a student in Ms. Harrison’s class at Southgate/Rippetoe Elementary School, placed 2nd in the Regional Spelling Bee held at Parmalee Elementary School in Oklahoma City. Finals will be held at *The Oklahoman Publishing Company* at 2:00 p.m. on March 25th.

The Moore School District has been invited to exhibit artwork at the State Department of Education’s gallery outside the State Superintendent’s office from April 3- May 12th.

Deji Dugger’s class at Fairview Elementary was recently highlighted in the Oklahoma Foundation for Excellence Newsletter. In December, Ms. Dugger’s students began a two-day excursion to Williamsburg from their schools’ computer lab, where they journeyed via the internet to explore the theme “The Industrious Trades”. As an additional note, Ms. Dugger has been selected by the National Endowment of Humanities to be a national essay contest reader. She will fly to Washington, D.C. to read and judge

essays written by students from all over the country. Only 4 teachers from across the nation were selected to read the essays.

Blake Allen, 6th grade student at Earlywine Elementary, has qualified for the State Geography Bee sponsored by National Geographic. Jill Wolfe is Blake's social studies teacher. The competition will be held on April 7th.

The district's elementary schools participated in the first Moore Elementary School Day at an OU Women's Basketball Game on February 18th. Even the bad weather could not keep participation down. 4,082 Moore Elementary School students and parents braved the slick roads to attend the game. -----In Secondary News:

Ryan Frampton of Westmoore High School has been named the 2005-2006 Gatorade Boys Soccer Player of the Year.

Brink Jr. High was chosen *Best Country Representation* for a junior high/middle school delegation at the Model United Nations of the Southwest Competition at OU in February.

Brink represented the Syrian Arab Republic, Thailand, and Cyprus. The Brink students representing the school were: Marcus Krueger, Sydney Caswell, Cori Brown, Ann Mai, Shelby White, Marsinah Starnes, and Matt Cooper. Student sponsors are: Whitney Stafford, Angela Dudley and Lana Echard.

Cleon Chai, from Brink Jr. High, has scored high enough on the qualifying test to represent Brink at the state Geography Bee to be held at OU on Friday, March 31st. The winner of the state competition will then compete at the National Bee in Washington, D.C.

Highland West Jr. High participated in a fund raising effort that far surpassed any that the school has done. The student council sponsored "Pennies for Patients", a campaign that supports the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society. The campaign ran from February 27th to March 3rd and consisted of a variety of events. A short benefit concert was held at a school assembly and \$3500 was presented to the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society.

Congratulations to the Moore High School Band. Over 100 members of the band competed in the District Solo and Ensemble contest in Mustang. The Moore Band had 42 different soloists and ensembles earn superior ratings. A total of 92 students qualified for

the State Solo and Ensemble Contests which translates to 74% if the entire Moore Band Program.

Congratulations to the Moore High School Baseball team for winning the High School Triple Play Challenge Tournament in Gilbert, Arizona over Spring Break.

The Westmoore Speech and Debate students have recently received honors at several tournaments. At the Norman tournament, the Westmoore students won 2nd place in Championship Team Sweepstakes and 3rd in 4A Team Sweepstakes. At the Norman North tournament, Westmoore won 1st place in Championship Team Sweeps and 3rd place in 4A Team

Sweepstakes. Because of individual placements as well as group placement at tournaments, Westmoore has qualified for Nationals competition in June. The speech and debate team is sponsored by Brett Young.

Congratulations to the Westmoore High School Girls' Basketball Team for being awarded the Academic State Championship Trophy.

Congratulations to Carl Franks, District Athletic Director, for receiving the 2005 State Award of Merit from the National Federation of State High School Associations for contributions to interscholastic athletics at both the local and state levels.

The Moore School District will be hosting the Oklahoma Challenge Cup match, a nationally recognized soccer match, on March 25th at the Moore Public Schools Stadium.

The Moore Public Schools Foundation Banquet will be held tomorrow evening at 6:30 p.m. at the South Penn Campus of the Moore Norman Career Tech.

The Excellence in Education Program will be held at Westmoore High School next Tuesday, March 28th with a reception at 6:00 p.m. and the program beginning at 7:00 p.m.
