Mrs. Arato presented the following information during the SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT:

District News:

On June 2, 2006, our district received tremendous news! We learned our district would receive almost \$1 million in federal grant funds to provide intensive training for our history teachers.

The grant--which totals \$999,670 – is part of a \$118.2 million fund being distributed to schools in 38 states. The funds are being used to immerse history teachers in American History content and research-based teaching strategies. **Moore was the only Oklahoma school to receive a grant this year.**

Shirley Starkey, our Social Studies curriculum coordinator, developed the application for our district. The funds will be directed at our 5th, 8th and 11th grade history teachers. They will tour historic sites for 12 days and have access to experts throughout that tour, plus these funds will allow us to take our history curriculum and expand it in depth with presentations and other types of information. Moore will partner with Mystic Seaport, West Point, the Oklahoma State History Museum and Oklahoma State University to improve the teaching of traditional American history.

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About 80 of our teachers will participate in the training which will begin this fall and continue throughout the life of the three-year grant.

Congratulations to Ms. Starkey and her staff for all their hard work. We appreciate you!!

Moore Public Schools was recently recognized by SchoolMatch as an honored "What Parents Want" school district. Only a very small percentage of school districts nationwide are bestowed this honor each year. Our district was noted for its quality of life, economic development, and public accountability which make it attractive for those families who might be relocating to our area.

The student was so upset about leaving Bonds Elementary for his home school that he was in tears. When he heard the news, Mr. Romines stopped by the student's home after school to personally say goodbye. The little boy couldn't wait to tell his friends, "Mr. Romines came to MY house to tell me good-bye".

Stories such as these are what make our schools a community. Congratulations to all our elementary school parents, teachers and administrators on an outstanding year.

In Secondary News:

Contingent upon funding from the state legislature, Moore Public Schools has been awarded six Great Expectations Summer Institute Scholarships. A GE summer institute will be held at Vista Academy this summer and Ms. Sandra Ludwig will be the site principal.

Great Expectations recently sent a video crew to Moore High School to capture classroom footage and interviews. This footage will be used in a training film for other high school teachers as they begin to implement Great Expectation practices. Dan Schwarz, Janel Cypert and Liz Butcher participated in the filmmaking.

Janel Cypert will be going through training to become an instructor this summer and Mike Coyle, Dan Schwarz, Connie Shelton (Moore High School), Jo Sauer, (Highland

East Junior High) and Michelle Grogan (West Jr. High) have all agreed to be presenters at Great Expectations Secondary Expo sessions.

Because of an error on the part of Cox Convention Center, Edmond high schools did not have graduation rehearsal times assigned for Friday, May 19th. They had planned graduation ceremonies at the Cox Convention Center on Saturday the 20th. They desperately needed practice time on Friday and Moore High School Principal Mike Coyle graciously agreed to allow the Edmond schools time to practice on Friday the 19th.
